

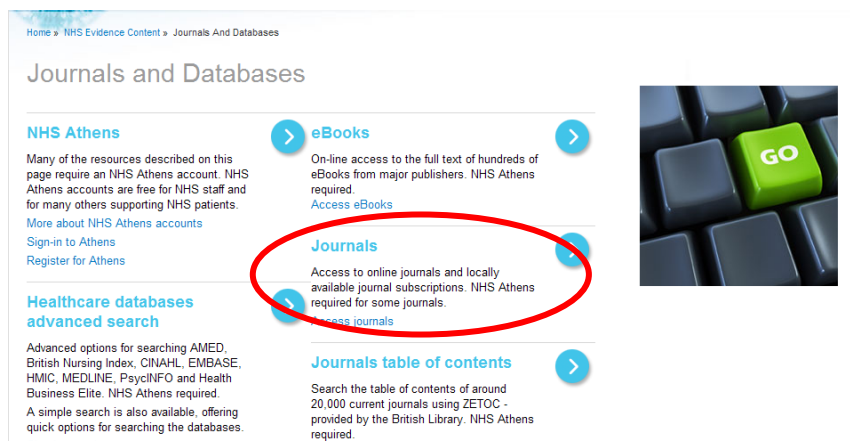

How do I find a particular journal?

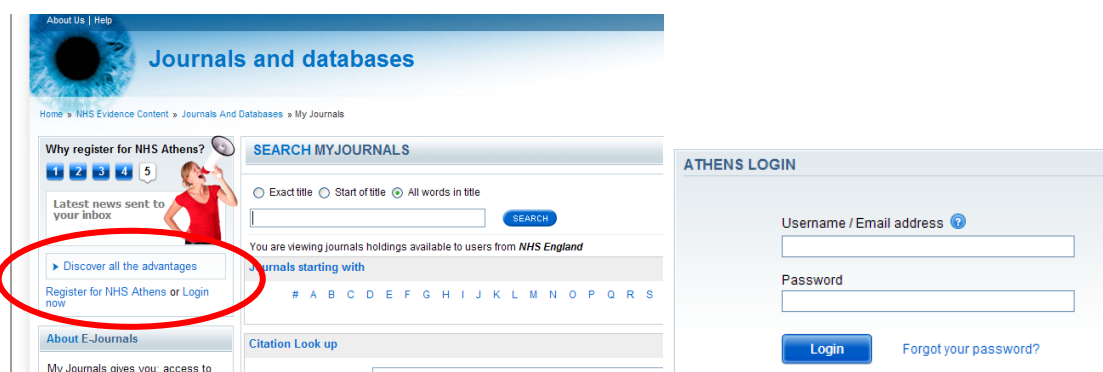
1. Go to:

<http://www.evidence.nhs.uk/>


2. Click on **Journals and Databases** then **'Journals'** (see images below).



3. You need to **Login to Athens** using your user name and password. If not you'll only have access to a limited number of free journals, not the full 4,400 we've purchased. If you don't have a login you can apply for one click on **'Register for NHS Athens'** – this will take up to 60 hours to come through.




4. You can then search for journals by **key word** or by specific **journal title** or **citation**.



Here - key word or journal title


Or here - specific journal title or citation

5. This will then display the **titles** and the **date ranges** available. Just click on the **blue links** to take you to these journals. You may need to re-enter your Athens login and password.

6. If the journal or article you require is unavailable you will received the message 'Total Records matched: 0'.
